- Women's league finished up August 20th
- The 3 other leagues will be over in September depending on any rainouts.

<mark>Field Team</mark>

- Irrigation issue on Hole #12 was repaired a leak in August and now good again.
- Irrigation leak on Hole #9, we replaced the issue with a New Sprinkler head.
- We change out our Pin placements twice a week.
- We continue our cut schedule (Fairways Cut and Rough cut 2 to 3 times per week based on weather.) Tee Boxes twice per week.
- Top Dressed and fertilized all the tee boxes in August.
- We Aerated ALL the greens in August and rolled them.
- Charlie and his team are addressed the collars on Holes 2,6,12,13,14 with overseeding and aeration. This process with take several months to repair.
- The team Mulched and landscaped around the trees and around the Hole sponsors. Weeds Whipped around the ponds.
- Charlie was instructed to remove the Non-Paying Hole sponsorships as early as possible.
- We used Patch to repair the entrance way and repaired Holes 5,6,8,11 and 13
