

## **Pickleball Court Rules**

**Any person entering upon the Pickleball Courts hereby agrees to be bound by the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Brookville as well as the following Rules:**

- 1. Courts are open daily from 8:00 A.M. until 10:00 P.M. and are for Pickleball use only and are open for first come/first served basis, subject to customary Pickleball etiquette, and may not be reserved except as outlined in Rule #12, below;**
- 2. Participants agree to use the Courts at their own risk and release the Town of Brookville from any liability for any and all injuries and/or damages that participants may incur while utilizing the Courts;**
- 3. To not abuse the Court nets or any other equipment provided and agree to be financially responsible for violations of this Rule;**
- 4. Pets, excluding ADA service animals, are prohibited on the Courts. Any other pets at the facility, not on the Courts, must be restrained by an adult at all times and may not be chained or tethered to any fencing;**
- 5. Rollerblades, skateboards, bicycles, motorized/manual scooters, etc. are prohibited on the Courts;**
- 6. Children 12 & under must be supervised by an adult;**
- 7. Alcoholic beverages & smoking/tobacco/vaping are prohibited on Town property including the entire Pickleball complex;**
- 8. No food and/or glass containers on the Courts;**
- 9. All chairs, bags & equipment must remain outside of court area;**
- 10. Athletic, non-marking shoes must be worn at all times on the Courts;**
- 11. Pickleball tournaments and/or leagues must be approved by the Brookville Town Council and participants must sign a Waiver provided by the Town of Brookville prior to tournament and/or league participation;**
- 12. Tournaments and/or leagues approved by the Brookville Town Council have priority over open play;**
- 13. No profane/abusive behavior or language will be tolerated nor permitted;**
- 14. Private instruction for pay is prohibited unless approved by the Brookville Town Council and compliance with any other business regulations of the Code of Ordinances;**
- 15. If there is an emergency, participants shall call 911.**
