Wastewater:

- Submitted one response letter to IDEM concerning the plant inspection in November.
- Researching Hydrogen Sulfide metering systems.
- Installed newly replaced polymer pump in press room.
- Damon Bauman registered to begin exam review classes in January.
- Buckeye Power Supply ran maintenance and testing of generator.
- Spoke with Starweld about examining the railings in the main lift station. They advised it would be after the first of the year.
- Kerr Electric installed new exhaust fan in electric room.

Water:

- Spoke to IDEM concerning a sanitary survey schedule at the water plant which was held December 12th.
- Tony Marshall registered to begin exam review classes in January.
- Buckeye Power Supply ran maintenance and testing of generator.
- GPS unit was purchased to mark utilities, when found, which do not locate easily with the conventional method. (Weber's Lane Gas Project)

Utility:
