

Monthly Update for September 2024

Water:

- Thomas Franks was hired at the Water Works.
- The Heap/Hofer pool bath house has been winterized.
- Spoke to Water Works employees about pool and park restroom winterizing procedures.
- Water Works employees have been going door to door and checking customer service lines.
- Water Works employees flushed mains.
- Located water and sewer mains while Water Works employees flushed mains.
- Water Works employees in conjunction with golf course employees found and disconnected the irrigation main around Hole # 11 for the slated excavation.
- Water Works assisted with residential water service line leak on Main Street.
- Water Works installed new tap on St Mary Road.

Wastewater:

- Kerr Electric getting quote for exhaust fan replacement in electrical room of plant.
- Kerr Electric, in conjunction with wastewater and street employees, pulled the pumps at the Twin Forks lift station and cleaned. The pumps were plugged tight with rags.

Utility:

- Sat in on scoring committee for comprehensive planning firms.

- Filed complaint of semi-tractor parked on 4th Street.
- Surveys for Town Street rights-of-way nearing completion. Took photos of surveys.
- Sat in on meeting with Triad Engineering to go over continuing projects.
- Spoke to Street Superintendent concerning the storm drainage at 7th and Long, and 6th and Mill Streets.
- Collaborated with the Police Department concerning code enforcement.
- Checked with golf course employees to determine where the irrigation main is located after leaving Reservoir Road.
- Checked with golf course employee to determine the location of the septic systems at the course.
- Worked with town resident on information concerning a water and sewer tap for a proposed new garage.
- Assisted Water Works employees in getting the flushing route, method, and routine, established.
- Worked with Hach Company to straighten out invoices for water analyzers.
- Received satisfactory inspection report from Tim Holtz for compost station.
- Attended training in Lawrenceburg on PFAS and other water contaminants.
- Went around with Duke Energy technician to ascertain the location of electric meters.
- Worked with Accessors, Recorders, and Surveyors office to straighten out the Town's deed where the High School water storage tank is located. It can now be located on the GIS mapping system.
- Street, Water, and Sewer, met with Janna Bingham, Indiana 811, to discuss locates, problems, and future requirements
